E. SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

Academics

- The session 2023 - 24 commenced from April 3, 2023 with great enthusiasm and a renewed commitment
- **Focus was laid on overcoming the learning gaps, achieving academic excellence, building character, and inculcating the habits of cleanliness and discipline**
- Academic calendar for the session 2023 - 2024 was prepared and adhered to religiously
- Syllabus bifurcation was done by teachers as per the number of working days for session 2023 - 24. Total working days were 238.
- The Honorable Secretary, Hamdard Education Society, Mr. Syed Samar Hamid met the teachers, department wise, to prepare a road map for the academic session 2023 - 24. The key motto was "Go beyond"
- Class tests were conducted regularly after the completion of every topic
- Special Revision classes were held for students of classes X and XII to help them perform well in Boards
- Enrichment classes were conducted for classes X and XII from May 22, 2023 to May 27, 2023
- Orientation session was undertaken by the Principal, Ms Saher M A Sayed, for students and staff
- Meetings with all the Unit Heads, HODs and Class Coordinators were held regularly to discuss the progress of the classes and to update them with the required strategies to be adopted for the teaching learning process
- Weekly lesson plan was submitted by teachers to the respective Unit Heads through HODs
- Weak Students were identified. Following Steps were taken for their improvement:
 - Teachers communicate with the parents
 - Special attention was given to these students in the Zero period by the respective class teachers
 - Remedial classes were held for classes IX to XII from 7:30 a.m. to 8:15 a.m.
- Daily Attendance Record was submitted by the teachers
- Communication Register for boarders was maintained and updated regularly. Homework was sent every day to the hostel
- Teachers constantly interacted with each other to share their ideas, methodologies and to plan out syllabus and weekly assignments
- Pre vacation examination and Pre-Board examinations was conducted for students of classes X and XII. The third Pre Board examination was held for those students who could not perform well in first two Pre-Board Examinations
- Subject Coordinators/HODs assessed every teacher of their department on monthly basis and forwarded the reports of the same to their Unit Heads. Subject Coordinators/HODs in turn were assessed by the Unit Heads and Principal. Regular mentoring and monitoring of the classes were done by the Principal and Unit Heads
- Teachers conducted revision classes for Hostel students
- Regular updates, on various issues related to academics were shared with the staff

- The blueprint of the question papers and syllabus for P.A. II and Annual Examination for classes VI to XII were prepared by the HODs (in consultation with respective subject teachers) for centralized system of Examination for the three schools which was forwarded to the Dr. Naheed R. Usmani
- CBSE Registration and LOC for classes IX to XII was completed timely
- To ensure meticulous checking, a special strategy was devised for the checking and rechecking of the answer scripts of the Annual Examination wherein the checking was not be done by the teacher teaching in the particular class but it was done by the parallel teacher of the same class and the rechecking was done by the main subject teacher

General Activities

- Stock checking was completed by all the teachers as per the schedule
- Entab mark entry training was given to the new teachers
- Special dispersal schedule was prepared and executed for the smooth dispersal of students
- Special timings and schedule were prepared for Fridays. Teachers offered namaz after the dispersal of students in order to supervise all students and ensure that discipline was maintained during the namaz and at the time of dispersal
- Monthly Reports of the school activities were maintained and sent to the Honourable Secretary, Mr. Samar Hamid, regularly
- Book fair was organized by Scholastic from August 24, 2023 to August 26, 2023
- National De worming drive was organised by DOE under the supervision of the school nurse
- Fumigation of medicine, to stop mosquito breeding, was done in the school
- Book Review was done by teachers of all the departments for finalizing the book list for the session 2024 - 2025. A meeting was held in HSC conference room to finalize the same
- Class Monitors were appointed by the Class Teachers and badges were conferred
- Class photographs were clicked for all classes I.e. Nursery to class XII
- Fee structure for the next academic year (2024 - 25) was finalized by the School Management Committee and the PTA body and sent to the DoE
- IT Maintenance Report and Smart Class update was mailed to the Department regularly
